



## South Australian-based services for people with visual impairment

SASVI - South Australian School for Visually Impaired	<a href="http://www.sasvi.sa.edu.au/">http://www.sasvi.sa.edu.au/</a>	Run by the Department of Education, a public school with outreach teachers for the whole of SA. Currently no early intervention is provided; check their website for updates.
Kilparrin School	<a href="http://www.kilparrin.sa.edu.au/">http://www.kilparrin.sa.edu.au/</a>	Based on the same site as SASVI, Kilparrin School is for children with vision/hearing impairment along with significant additional needs including autism, Down syndrome and cerebral palsy.  Provides early intervention for children from birth to school age.
Can:Do4Kids	<a href="http://www.cando4kids.com.au/">http://www.cando4kids.com.au/</a>	A charity that assists children with hearing and vision difficulties based in SA. Provides a range of services, some funded by NDIS. Helps with NDIS applications.

GlassesSA	<a href="http://www.sa.gov.au/topics/care-and-support/financial-support/concessions/GlassesSA">http://www.sa.gov.au/topics/care-and-support/financial-support/concessions/GlassesSA</a>	A scheme that assists those needing glasses (with applicable concession cards) with only a small gap to pay.  Most patients requiring glasses and contact lenses have to pay privately for them in full in SA. Patients attending the Women's and Children's Hospital or Flinders Medical Centre (the only two paediatric ophthalmology public hospital sites in SA) who have a clinical need for contact lenses are fully funded, either by the hospitals themselves, or through the GlassesSA scheme.
